- Understand your organization and its particular context

- Define the scope of your environmental management system
- Establish and maintain an environmental management system.

### 5 Leadership

- Provide leadership by accepting responsibility for the EMS
- Provide leadership by establishing an environmental policy
- Provide leadership by assigning EMS roles and responsibilities.

### 6 Planning

- Formulate actions to address your risks and opportunities
- Set environmental objectives and make plans to achieve them.

### 7 Support

- Support your EMS by providing the necessary resources
- Support your EMS by ensuring that people are competent
- Support your EMS by making people aware of their duties
- Support your EMS by controlling your communications
- Support your EMS by managing documented information

### 8 Operations

- Establish your EMS processes and control how they operate
- Establish your emergency preparedness and response processes.

### 9 Evaluation

- Determine your environmental performance and compliance
- Audit your organization's environmental management system
- Review your organization's environmental management system.
